1. Product Description

Textile Made-Ups can be defined as the textile products fabricated for other than apparel purposes. It consists of a range of functional as well as decorative products, mainly including towels and cleaning cloths, bed wear and bed linen, blankets, curtains and furnishings, canvas products and table linen.

The Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (referred as HS Codes) designated for trade of Textile Made-Ups is 63. The brief description of sub categories falling with-in product category of HS 63 is provided in the following table:

Table 1: Textile Made-Up Product Details

Product Category HS Code	Product Description
6302	Bed linen, table linen, towels and kitchen linen of all types of textile materials
6307	Made-up articles such as cleaning clothes including dress patterns and life jackets
6305	Sacks and bags used for the packing of goods
6304	Articles for interior furnishing, e.g curtains, drapes, interior blinds, lampshades
6301	Blankets and travelling rugs of all types of textile materials
6303	Curtains, including drapes, and interior blinds
6306	Tarpaulins, awnings and sun blinds; tents; sails for boats, sailboards or land craft
6309	Worn clothing and clothing accessories, blankets and travelling rugs
6310	Rags, scrap twine, cordage, rope and cables and worn-out articles
6308	Woven fabric and yarn sets for making tapestries, rugs, table cloths

2. Global Trade of Textile Made-Ups

Textile Made-Ups are one of the most valuable and important commodities in international trade. During the year 2016, the international trade value of Textile Made-Ups was USD 60.04 Billion. The exports have shown a mixed growth trend with an average growth rate of 1.20 % from the year 2012 ~ 16. The last five years' exports of Textile Made-Ups in global trade are as follows:




Figure 1: Growth Trend of Textile Made-Ups Exports (Value US \$ Billion)

Major Exporters



Product Mix - Share in Exports

3. Pakistan's Exports


Pakistan is one of the major exporting countries of Textile Made-Ups with availability of high quality raw material and skilled labor force. Over the years, export figures have shown tremendous growth, showing a mixed growth trend in last 5 years with an average growth rate of 1.02 % from the year 2012 $^{\sim}$ 16. During the year 2016, the exports value of Textile Made-Ups was US \$3,803 Million. Pakistan's last five years' export figures of Textile Made-Ups are as follows:





Figure 6: Trade Partners of USA (Avg. % Share in Export Value – Last 5 Years)







Figure 8: Trade Partners of Japan (Avg. % Share in Export Value – Last 5 Years)

From the above graphical descriptions, it is clear that Pakistan has been able to tap the market of United States of America and Germany relatively well, however, China is leading the exports in both. Surprisingly, Pakistan's exports to Japan, which is the third largest importing country, are miserably low. Therefore, Pakistani exporters should also target the Japanese market that has huge export potential.

Figure 9: Price Comparison for Bed, Table & Kitchen Linen and Towels (HS 6302, US \$ / Ton)




Figure 10: Price Comparison for Curtains and Home Furnishings (HS 6303, US \$ / Ton)





Figure 11: Price Comparison for Cleaning Cloths, Dress Patterns and Life Jackets (HS 6307, US \$ / Ton)

5. Pakistan's Export Trade and Tariff

- There is a 5% rebate on the exports of all value-added goods in textile sector including Textile Made-Ups. However, the rebate is applied if there is a 10 percent incremental increase in exports over the preceding year.
- A General Sales Tax on exports of Textile Made-Ups is 2%, which is refundable.
- Custom Rebate or Duty Drawback also exists whose percentage varies from item to item imported as raw material for Textile Made-Ups.
