Under the project legal services outreach shall be extended to small businesses including home based enterprises, small shopkeepers, growers, women entrepreneurs, hawking vendors etc. In addition, small business shall be mobilized to access legal services.

1. APPOINTMENT

The Business hereby appoints the Auditor for the auditing of the accounts of the Business, and such other services which are incidental to this appointment and performance of the Services under this Agreement.

2. SCOPE AND LOCATION OF SERVICES

- (1) The Services shall be provided, including auditing, at the location of the Business' registered offices where the project bookkeeping is done.
- (2) "Services" under this Agreement shall mean and include the auditing and examination of balance sheets, statements of revenue, expenses and changes in net assets of the Business for the period beginning from [insert date] and ending on [insert date] (hereinafter referred to as the "Accounting Period").
- (3) The Auditor shall also provide such services to the Business as may be reasonably required by the Business, and which are incidental to the performance of the Services under this Agreement.

3. AUDIT COSTS AND REMUNERATION

- 2) This Remuneration Amount shall cover all fees and expenses incurred by the Auditor, and the Business shall not be liable to pay any other expenses incurred by the Auditor during the provision of Services under this Agreement.
- 3) The Remuneration shall be payable by the Business to the Auditor in accordance with the following schedule:

4. AUDITING PROCEDURE

- (1) The Services under this Agreement shall be provided in accordance with national regulations as well as the generally accepted international auditing standards.
- (2) The audit/examination shall include such tests of the accounting records and such other auditing procedures as are considered by the Auditor to be necessary in the circumstances.

5. DELIVERABLES

- (1) The Auditor shall, after completing his examination and audit of the Business, submit to the Business a written report of audit. This report shall include, at least, the basic financial statements and notes thereto prepared in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles, supplementary information requested by the Business or required for full disclosure under the law, and the Auditor's opinion on the material presented.
- (2) The Auditor shall furnish [insert number] copies of a written Audit Report to the Business, as soon as practical, after the close of the Accounting Period.
- (3) The written Audit Report shall include the following:
 - Statement explaining criteria and scope as well as duration and location of the auditing conducted;
 - ii. Statement as to the scope of auditing;
 - iii. Statement as to deviations, if any;
 - iv. Schedule of verified receipts and payments;
 - v. Statement as to correct and proper accounting procedures;
 - vi. Statement as to compliance or variance with the recommendations of previous audit reports, if any;
 - vii. Statement to the effect that all receipts and payments correctly relate to the specified project (or don't), and are (or are not) correct with regard to the calculations involved;

viii. If the report is a qualified one, the reasons for the qualification shall be explained;

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

- (1) The Auditor shall take all steps necessary to ensure the secret and confidential nature of all information he/she may acquire under the provisions of this Agreement.
- (2) The Auditor shall make available his/her findings and report only and exclusively to the Business.

7. FORCE MAJEURE

- (1) Force Majeure shall mean any event that is beyond the reasonable control of a Party, or the effects of which adversely affect the performance by such Party of its obligations under this Agreement, including, but not limited to, acts of God, sabotage, insurrection, terrorism, riots, hostilities or war (whether declared or not), acts of the public enemy, civil disturbances, any kind of fire, explosion, flood or accidental damage, epidemics, landslides, washouts, lightening, storms, earthquakes, lockouts, blockades, shortage of labor or material, major equipment failure, or other causes beyond the control of the Party affected.
- (2) Notwithstanding anything contained hereinabove, neither Party shall be liable to the other if it is unable to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement due to the occurrence of Force Majeure.
- (3) The Party affected by the Force Majeure event shall be entitled to suspend performance of its obligations under the Agreement to the extent that such performance is impeded or made impossible by the events of Force Majeure.
- (4) Each Party shall give a notice within [insert number] days of the occurrence of the event of Force Majeure and shall promptly thereafter consult the other Party for the purpose of finding a mutually acceptable solution to the Force Majeure event.

8. GOVERNING LAW AND EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION

This Agreement in all respects be read and construed and shall operate as a contract, in conformity with the laws of Pakistan, and the courts at [insert place] shall have exclusive jurisdiction for adjudicating any dispute arising hereunder.

9. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE

Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the Pakistan Arbitration Act, 1940, subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of [insert place].
