#### LEGAL SERVICES, SMEDA

If the Claimant has instituted any legal proceedings against the Business regarding any claim which is settled by this Agreement, the Claimant covenants to have the same withdrawn at the Claimant's own cost, and with express prejudice to bringing further proceedings, arising out of the same matter, against the Business.

3. The Claimant also covenants not to make any claim or institute any proceedings against any person who might claim contribution or indemnity from the Business in connection with any matter for which this Agreement is executed.

4. The Claimant also acknowledges that the Business does not admit any liability to the Claimant in connection with any matter for which this Agreement is executed, and further more expressly denies any such liability.

5. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the Parties, their successors, assigns and personal representatives.

6. The Parties agree and acknowledge that no other debt, obligation, or liability by and between the Parties, which if existing, shall survive this release.

7. That the receipt of the Consideration Amount shall be construed as a complete settlement and satisfaction of the actions, causes of action, claims and demands with respect to the matter for which this Agreement is executed.

8. This Agreement envisages the entire agreement between the Parties, and the recitals hereto form and integral part of the Agreement.

9. This Agreement shall be subject to and governed by the laws of Pakistan.
